
Each check or in our case pubs kept the 25 strong hash pack together with the help of traffic lights.

Round 2 of the Raffle Draw was held after that lot of charges.

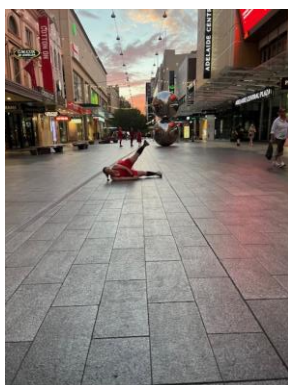
It went on and on and on until the prizes finally ran out.
