Destination 5

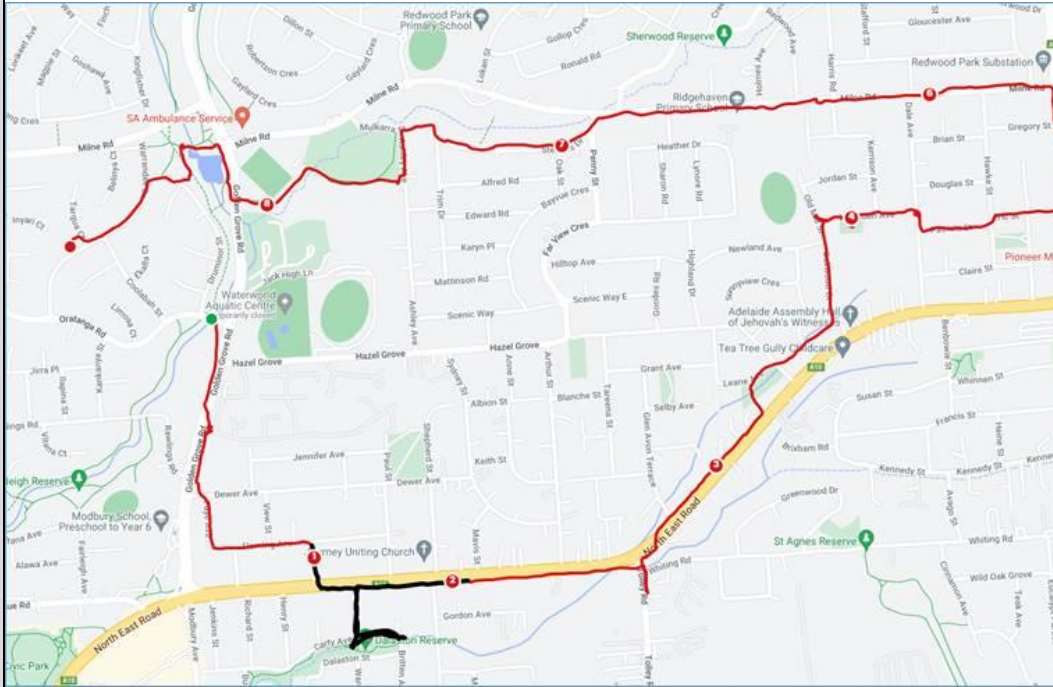
There is a Tennis club near by where you can have a hit

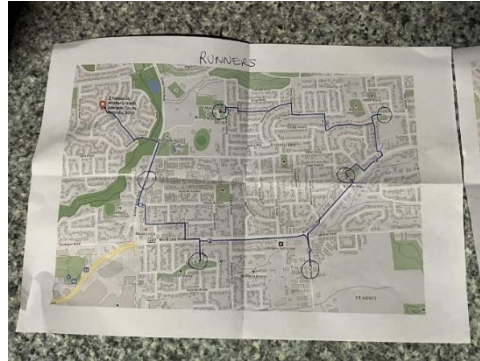
