

Run 2585 3 March 2025 Hares: Unstoppable & MoPed 15 hashers & 1 dog

Venue: Beefacres Reserve, 14 Pittwater Drive, Windsor Gardens

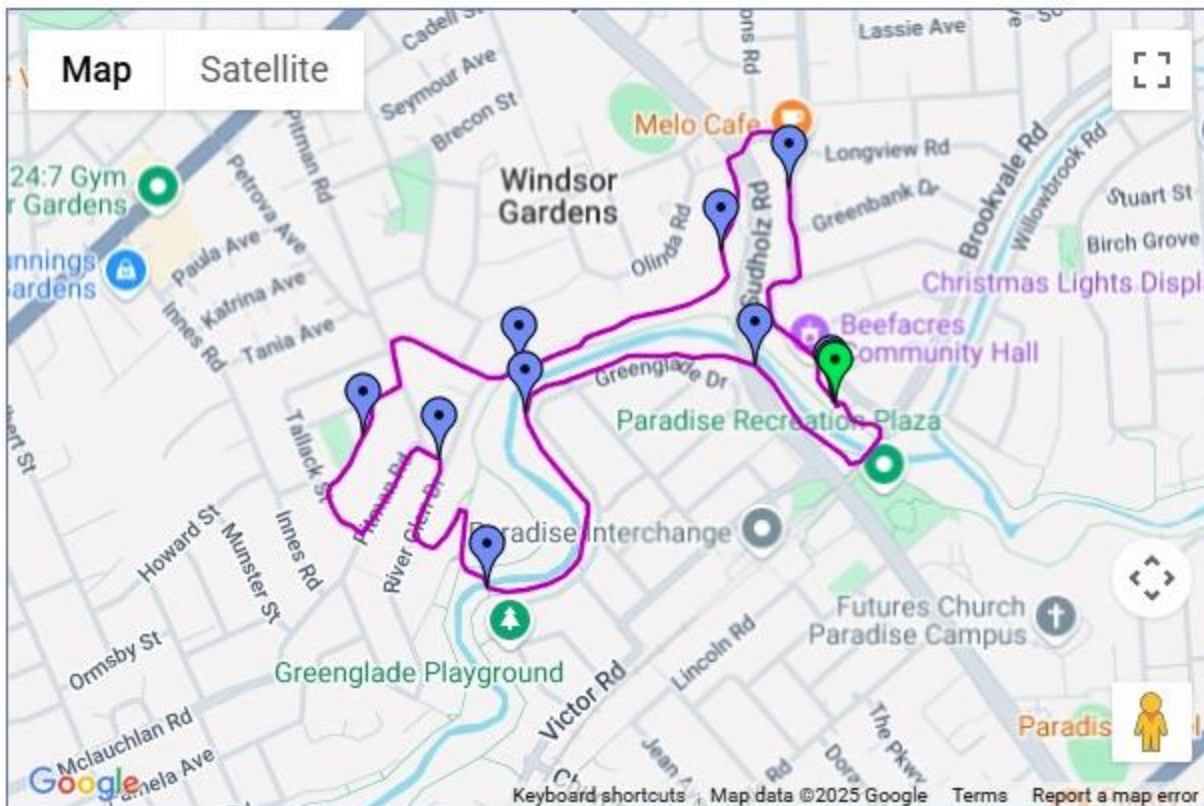
